



Angle Community Council Environmental Policy

1. Introduction

Angle Community Council (ACC) is committed to both the area and the people and the heart of the service we are elected for. That means balancing the needs of the local community with any environmental consequences from that decision.

2. The Policy

The aim of this policy is to provide guidance to councillors and employees on how they should minimise the impact on the environment. ACC is committed to keeping the geographical areas of Angle community reasonably clean and green and a more prosperous place to live and work.

Our environmental policy supports these goals. Through it we will use our limited powers and influence to protect and improve the environment and make continual improvement.

3. Scope of the Policy

We endeavour to affect the environment through our services and policies, enforcement of laws and regulations, the choices we make when buying goods and services – as well as our role as a community leader.

4. Environmental Impact during Planning

ACC will consider all known environmental implications when considering planning applications. We will act to prevent or minimise pollution to air, water or land, including noise pollution, litter, fly tipping and the impact of car travel. This will include:

- Protect and, where possible, enhance the quality, extent and accessibility of all open space.
- Contribute to the creation of a sustainable built environment through the planning process and our own developments.
- Consider all environmental impact and resource depletion due to additional volume of people and traffic in the area.
- Ensure all materials being used in any building or project are in keeping with local architecture and local planning authority regulations.
- Encourage biodiversity where possible.
- Source sustainable products where possible subject to other factors, eg weather.



5. Use of Contractors

ACC will only fund and/or contract certified and registered contractors for any works carried out. They will ensure that all community groups they fund will do the same. We will work with our contractors and suppliers to help them improve their environmental performance and ensure that, when working for ACC, they adopt equivalent environmental standards. All companies must be;

- Certified with the relevant bodies in their area of service.
- A registered company (where applicable).
- Hold all relevant environmental and protection insurance.
- Hold business/public liability insurance as a minimum.

6. Involvement and Inclusion

ACC will enable the full involvement of Community Councillors and employees by providing information, training and other support as appropriate. The public should be actively encouraged to express their concerns/suggestions in the appropriate way.
