Active Travel Network Map Consultation – Phase 2 ***Walking, Wheeling and Cycling in Pembrokeshire*** **Have Your Say: Help Shape Pembrokeshire's Active Travel Network**

Pembrokeshire County Council is updating its **Active Travel Network Map (ATNM)** and we want to hear from you.

Under the **Active Travel (Wales) Act 2013**, all local authorities in Wales must regularly review and enhance their walking, wheeling and cycling routes. Our current map was approved by the Welsh Government in 2022, and we are now reviewing it to reflect the changes that have been made since then.

Following a 12-week statutory consultation, that concluded in April this year legislation requires councils to give the public an opportunity to confirm that their views have been properly considered. This consultation represents that next stage.

We are asking for your feedback on the following:

- Have we identified appropriate potential new routes?
- Have we correctly identified existing routes which could be improved?
- Are we accurate in our assessment of routes that already meet the agreed standards (existing routes)?

The consultation focuses on the main towns and villages in Pembrokeshire which have been selected by the Welsh Government as the designated localities in the County. These are: Fishguard / Goodwick, Pembroke, Pembroke Dock, Tenby, Saundersfoot, Haverfordwest, Neyland, Milford Haven, Johnston, Narberth and St Dogmaels.

Please note that this consultation does not include issues relating to Public Rights of Way or any Highway matters not associated with walking, wheeling or cycling as these are not covered in the Active Travel Network Map review.

You can take part in the consultation exercise online through our interactive mapping tool, hosted by Data Map Wales which comes under the jurisdiction of Welsh Government.

The interactive map allows participants to view our proposed routes, known as future routes or existing ones that have been altered as a result of the initial consultation and comment on whether these routes reflect what you want to see introduced or improved.

The consultation will commence on Monday 3rd August 2026 and close Monday 28th September 2026.
